Pen Pal / Email Grade Sheet (60 pts.)

Students have been provided with access codes. All students have been supplied with a Sample Question Sheet. Students are to meet the following quality standards in their emails.

- At least 5 questions about the Pen Pal and where they live. (See model email below.).
- 2. At least 5 sentences sharing your life. (See model email below.).
- 3. There shall be no typographical errors.
- 4. There shall be no grammatical errors.
- 5. All correspondence shall have correct punctuation.
- 6. All correspondence shall begin with a salutation, such as, Hello "Pen Pal's Name",
- 7. All correspondence shall end with another salutation and your name.
- 8. You must place: 1.your name and 2. the color of the class (green, blue or black) somewhere in the "Subject" line of the email, so that I can give you credit.
- 9. Copy Mr. Harrington on all correspondence (cc.): jharrington@epals.com Note: Mr. Harrington is willing to review your email prior to you sending it.

When Mr. Harrington receives the email, he will review it to see if it meets all the quality standards stated above. If it does, the student will receive full credit – no partial credit will be given.

All emails must be sent between the dates stated below and midnight of the day it is due. Eg: the 1^{st} email has to be sent by midnight on the 8^{th} ; the 2^{nd} email has to be sent between the 9^{th} and midnight on the 11^{th} .
