Video Production – Skills Performance "My Life"

Student's will create a movie about themselves, "My Life." The content of each individual movie should reflect on a student's life beyond school.

Step #1: Submit a Storyboard (20 pts)

A storyboard must be submitted prior to shooting the video. A storyboard is a visual representation of what is to be filmed. (student will be supplied with a storyboard).

Step #2: Film the Video
