**Digital Photography – Video Conferencing** (40 pts)



## Guidelines

You and a partner will develop a slideshow showing many of the beautiful aspects of our campus. You will have two class periods to assemble it, using iPhoto. You will begin by taking pictures of campus scenes you feel are beautiful – architecture, flowers, plants, trees, shadows, etc. Remember our quality standards: Framing, Lighting & Background. The slide should have background music composed by you using Garage Band. Partners will develop their productions via video-conferencing (iChat). By the end of the 2<sup>nd</sup> class period, you will have exported and submitted your slide show as a movie. During the 3rd class period, students will judge and vote for what they feel are the best productions.

Creating the appropriate slideshow?

You have been shown several ways to create a slideshow in iPhoto. For this competition, you need to follow the method that will allow you to 'export' when you are done. 1. Highlight the photos you want in your slideshow, 2. Choose "+" then select "slideshow". (5pts.)

Your slideshow may not be longer than 1 minute and no shorter than 40 seconds. (5pts.)	No slide may appear longer than 4 seconds and not less than 3 seconds. (5pts.)
Your slide show will contain a music created by you using Garage Band. You may use the previous song you created. Your composition should not contain any vocals. (5pts.)	The opening slide should state you and your partner's names (the slideshow name can be changed by selecting the slide show file in the iPhoto archive and rename the file – the opening slide will automatically rename itself. (5pts.)
Collaboration – all slideshows and music compositions will be created and assembled by all partners utilizing Video Conferencing (iChat). All communication shall take place via the computer. (10pts.)	You are to successfully export your slideshow as a "Medium" movie file and transfer it to the instructor. It is to be titled with the last name of the members of your group. (5pts.)
