Step #1: “Jet Fighter” Green Screen. (100 pts.)

See Timeline Screen Shot On Back!

In Preparation:		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> View the “Jet Fighter” video on the class website. This is what you will be recreating. 		
Step #1: Retrieve the videos, photos and audio files from the RLS Multimedia Server – “JetFighter_GreenScreen.” Place the folder on your desktop		5 pts.
Step #2: Create A New Event & Project 2a: Create a New Event and Project and title it “JetFighter_YourName”. 2b: An explanation of Events and Projects.		5 pts.
Step #3: Import Audio, Video & Images into Final Cut Pro 3a. Import Audio and Video into “Final Cut Pro.” 3b. Import Images to “Photos” & Create an Album. 3b1. Problems Viewing “Photos” In Final Cut Pro...then import!		5 pts.
Step #4: Titles: Add a title slide to the beginning of the movie: “Jet Fighter” & “Attacking The Cruiser.”		5 pts.
Step #5: Assemble Images & Clips on the Timeline/Move Clips/Delete/Edit Undo/Zoom In & Out 5a. Assemble images and video clips on the Timeline. (5pts.) 5b. Move the Images and & Movie Clips on the Timeline. (5pts.) 5c. Delete and “Edit Undo”. (5pts.) 5d. Zoom In & Zoom Out. (5pts.)		20 pts.
Step #6: Create the 1st Green Screen Segment & Review: Snapping & Zoom! Pilot is talking to pilots.		10 pts.
Step #7: Create the 2nd Green Screen Segment: Pilot Fires on the cruiser and hits it.		10 pts.
Step #8: Create 3rd Green Screen: The pilot is ordering everyone home.		10 pts.
Step #9: Motion & Ken Burns Effect: 9a: Add Motion & Change the Size of the “Front Fighter.” (5pts.) 9b: Add Motion & Change the Size of the to “Back Fighter.” (5pts.) 9c: Add Motion to “Cruiser.” (5pts.) 9d: Add the “Ken Burns Effect” to the Explosion. (5pts.)		20 pts.
Step #10: Sound Effects & Audio You are being supplied with sound effects and music. View the image on the back of this page and the tutorial. Recreate how the audio files are organized on both.		10 pts.
Step #2: Each Student Becomes A Fighter Pilot (30 pts.)		
Step #1: Green Screen Each Student will be filmed in front of the green screen flying a fighter and stating a few lines.		10 pts.
Step #2: Download Video Each student will successfully download their film to Final Cut Pro on their computer.		10 pts.
Step #3: Edit “Jet Fighter” Each student will remove the pilot I provided you with and insert themselves in each scene.		10 pts.
Step#3: Add Animation & Sound Effects (30 pts.)		
In Preparation:		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> View the “Jet Fighter” video on the class website. This is what you will be recreating. 		
Step #1: Retrieve the laser images and sound effects from the RLS Multimedia Server. Place folder on your desktop.		
Step #2: Add Lasers - Animation. (Add a minimum of 5 lasers to Each jet fighter.) Here are the 9 steps you will follow to create an animation: 1. Select Clip. 2. Transform Image <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Note: This tutorial will teach you how to change the size (Transform!) of a laser. Remember to use this skill to change the size of objects in your future Star Wars scenes (eg. R2D2). Slide the Playhead to the beginning of the clip. 3. Drag the image to the end point. 4. Select Keyframe. 5. Drag the image to the start point. 6. Drag the play head to the end of the clip - click on the left arrow on the keyboard once so you see the laser. 7. Drag the image to the end point once again...you should see a red line. 8. Select Done!		20 pts.
Step #3: Add Sound Effects Add a laser sound effect to each of the lasers you created.		5 pts.
Step #4: Add Background Music & Volume Change Add background music to the entirety of your film. When someone is speaking, turn down the volume		5 pts.

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
